Dear parents / carers,

This is the final letter before we go on our school Journey to the Isle of Wight – please *note the earlier return time on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June.*

- On **Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June** we will be travelling to the Isle of Wight. Your child should come to school in clothes suitable for travel, **at 8.30am** and meet in the Year 6 classroom.
- They should have all their kit packed in a suitcase or holder that they can carry (packing list attached).
- If they have medicines that they need to take whilst away they should be packed in a small container that is clearly labelled with their name and instructions for use.
- Travel sickness tablets for the outward journey should already have been taken. Tablets for the return journey should be in a clearly marked envelope with the exact dosage needed.
- All medicine will be collected and looked after by our first aider Lisa Staff.
- Pocket money. There is a small shop at the site. The organisers suggest that £10 is quite sufficient. The money should be sealed in a clearly labelled envelope.
- Don't forget sunscreens and hats.
- Please make sure your child does not pack any phones or electrical devices.
- Your child will need a packed lunch for the outward journey.

We shall be contacting the school every day to inform them of what we have done and how it is going. The school will relay this information to you via text messaging. You may need to check with the office that they have your correct mobile number.
