




Think about where: 1) the story starts 2) they travel to next 3) the big event happens 4) the story ends. I would like you to draw each setting as though you are illustrating it for a children’s book and annotate it with expanded noun phrases, similes, metaphors, personification, etc. Think about using the 5 senses to describe what it is like to be there – see, feel, smell, taste and hear.</p> <p>Keep all this work together so that if we come back to school we can complete this in class as a project.</p>
