What support systems do we have in place?

We have a wide range of expertise within the school and following is available for pupils with SEN. An identification and assessment process is embedded within the school to ensure children access appropriate and purposeful expertise and provision.

Zaineb Shah is our Learning Mentor and Designated Safeguarding Officer responsible for addressing children's emotional and social needs and transition to other placements. Jacquie Boulton is the Ethnic Minorities Achievement Lead and also our Better Reader Support Partner Lead. She ensures it is monitored and reviewed regularly for impact and progress. She liaises with teaching staff to observe, assess and advise on children presenting with additional needs. At Hollickwood we are committed to ensuring that staff are trained to meet the needs of pupils with additional needs and their knowledge is updated when necessary. Teachers and Teaching assistants have been trained to provide many provisions including: Letters and Sounds, Project X, Universal Speech and Language Training, Numicon, First Class @Number 1&2, Success @ Arithmetic, 15 Minutes Reading, Better Reading Support Partners and Precision Teaching.

Local Authority Expertise:

We have strong relationships with external professional services such as Speech and Language and the Educational Psychology Service, who may be requested to assess a child's needs and contribute to an EHC plan. Parents are contacted to discuss any concerns or extra support they may be receiving including referrals to outside professionals.
